




Eastern vs Western Culture

How do you understand the Bible?





The Bible, as we have come to know and love, is a very misunderstood manuscript. From its divine inspiration (2 Timothy 3:16), to its Hebrew origins, the Bible has been under scrutiny for thousands of years. The first thing you must understand before reading any further is this. Those that have been born and reared within the western culture have a very distorted view of the Bible. Many may find that their interpretations of this divine text are naturally flawed, simply based on the cultural lens that we view the world.

Here are examples to prove this point. The Bible was written in the Middle East and its authors were all HEBREW. Now on the surface that might seem like a small matter; however, that could not be further from the truth. The Bible was written in a land far from the Americas, and speaks of a people with a distinctly different culture than the dominant culture of the United States we know today. The language and culture of the Bible are polar opposites from the mainstream culture here in the United States.

The written and cultural language of the Bible is

Hebrew. We speak English as the dominant language and our culture is blended from many nations that have migrated here.

Hebrew is read from right to left. English is read from left to right.

Here are a few quick examples.




The Western world is very abstract (relative/subjective). The Bible's culture (Hebrew) is concrete (definite).



Our mainstream culture of the United States is rooted in Greco-Roman values (look at the principles and beliefs of the Founding Fathers of the US). The Bible's culture is rooted in a distinct Hebraic culture.

These are easy examples for any objective person evaluating the two cultures to notice. We urge you to continue reading for more revelation on this subject. In order to connect with the Bible on a spiritual level, you **MUST** get a clear understanding of these foundational concepts. The first thing you must completely embrace is the fact that the Bible is Hebriac, **PERIOD**. Did you know that the Hebrew Calendar does not start on January 1st? The Western world (the society in which we live in) values holidays such as St. Patrick's Day, MLK Day, April Fool's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving, birthdays, Christmas, etc. We think you get the point. However, the hard reality for those that say they live by the Bible is that NONE of these "holidays" are mentioned or practiced in the Hebraic societies of the Bible. None of them! So, why do professing Christians celebrate them? There is one answer to this question and it is simple...TRADITION. The celebration of holidays is a deeply rooted tradition of Gentile nations within the western culture. What we fail to realize is that we have completely ignored our Heavenly Father's command when it comes to the **COMMANDED** holy days that are to be observed. All of the Hebrew writers observed the Holy days that were commanded to be kept "throughout the generations" (Leviticus 23:31).

Feast of Trumpets - Leviticus 23:24, 25


Day of Atonement - Leviticus 23:27, 28


